

To Whom It May Concern,

This is to confirm that GoIndustry was appointed via PG Bison on 15th May 2008 to auction and sell machinery and scrap for the plant closure of PG Bison Stellenbosch.

Various contractors were appointed to dismantle, remove and scrap equipment from the site. As the total site was classed as a demolition the Department of Labour was notified and a Permit to Work applied for by PG Bison as the principle contractor. Due to the stringent enforcement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act regulations Dave Marock was appointed as the Safety Health & Environment Officer Construction Regulation 6(6) to the largest sub contractor. In December 2008 due to the economic worldwide crisis the largest subcontractor left site as the contract was no longer economically viable due to the collapse of the scrap price.


GoIndustry was appointed the Principle Contractor in December 2008. Dave Marock was appointed Projects/Contracts Manager Construction regulation Section 16(2) plus continued in the role of Safety Officer.

We would like to confirm that these disruptions placed the contract behind schedule and over cost budget. Dave Marock took over and set a new financial budget with a new agreed completion date. Dave finished the project under the financial allowed spend and within the new time line.

In closing Dave Marock performed his total management function professionally and we would recommend him as a Project Manager on any other project.
